1. Motion to approve the assignment of the Lease of Orleans Marina Boathouse Site No. N-5, located at municipal address 158 South Roadway Street, New Orleans, LA 70124, and sale of the improvements located on the leased premises, by 158 S. Roadway, LLC to Mitzi M. Taylor, conditioned on payment of the Five (5%) Percent transfer fee, in the amount of \$10,925.00, and assumption of all obligations of the lessee under the Lease.

2. Discussion of the request to amend the lease for Felix's to permit Live Entertainment and Outdoor Live Entertainment secondary uses in addition to the primary use of standard restaurant, as permitted by the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance.

Melissa Quiggley, representative for Felix's restaurant, commented that they have had (2) public engagement meetings. Theu used the City's notifications system. There was good attendance where residents expressed their grievances. They performed noise decibel testing and have since moved the bands to another corner. They will be adding noise-proofing equipment. They request a lease amendment to allow for music. They are working with councilman Green's office.

<u>Chair Thomas</u>, identified herself as Councilman Green's staffer and said there has not been engagement with Councilmember Green's office. The person she is working with is in another office. However, Councilman Green is waiting for the noise testing report.

Ms. Quiggley stated that they heave made several attempts to no avail to an email address she read to Chair Thomas.

<u>Commissioner Scott</u> asked if there had been any other testing since the sound proofing.

Chair Thomas asked if there had looked into any other sound barriers.

Ms. Quiggley said that they had not installed the sound proofing yet and they are looking at various sound proofing options.

Chair Thomas announced the next meetings and called for adjournment.
